Paying for PACE

PACE allows participants to use both Medicare and Medicaid to access and pay for services. Once enrolled, there are no benefit limits, deductibles or copayments for any services provided or coordinated by your PACE of Cincinnati care team.

Some participants may have a premium, depending on your financial situation. Our team will explain your options and can also help determine Medicaid eligibility.

All services must be provided by or authorized by the PACE Interdisciplinary Team (except emergency services). PACE participants may be held liable for costs for unauthorized or out-of-PACE program agreement services.
